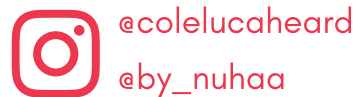

Heard's collection features the silhouettes and emotions felt from the Orchid flower, which "reminds [me] of home" in South Africa. The flower is culturally and personally significant to Heard's family. The beautiful garments Heard has prepared flow and are inspired by the flowers shape itself.

Nuha Ahmad's designs are influenced by Jordanian Bedouins, a nomadic group of people living in Jordan. Ahmad's adoration for their simple clothing, color scheme, and complex accessories shines in her streetwear collection designed "to show that 'Arab' culture is more diverse than people make it out to be." -Ahmad
